📊 What's changed?

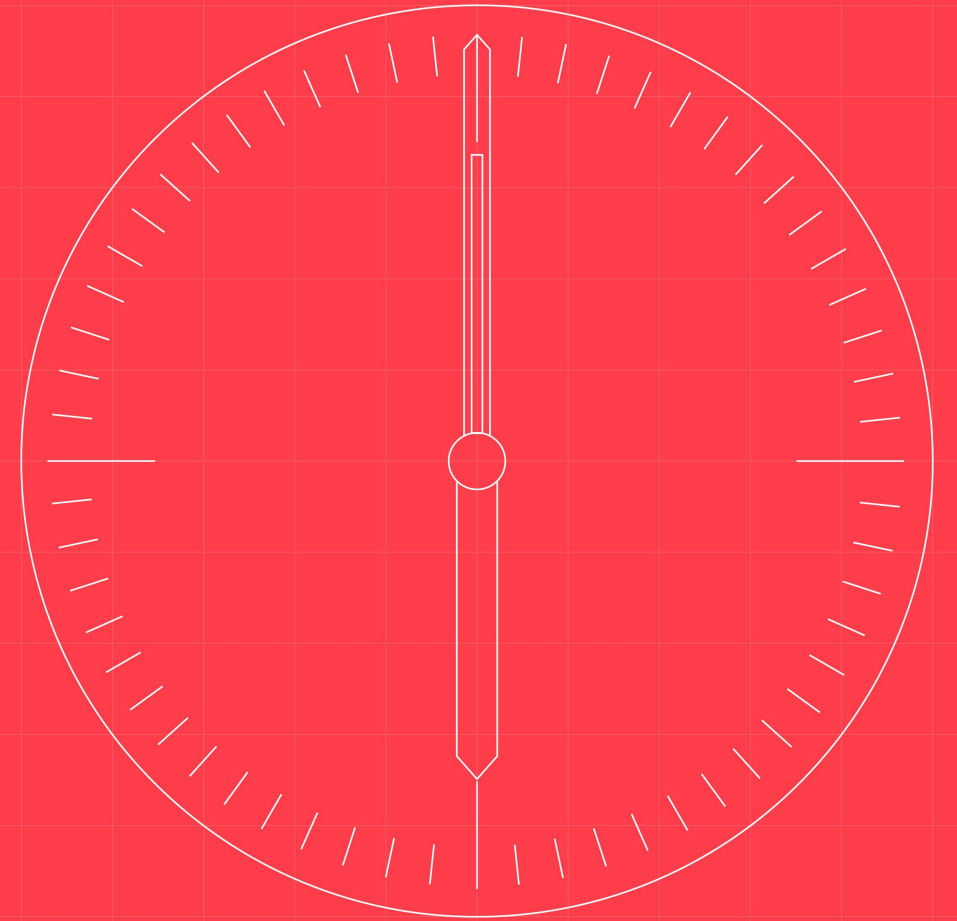
- We have listened to your feedback and enhanced the site to provide a better user experience

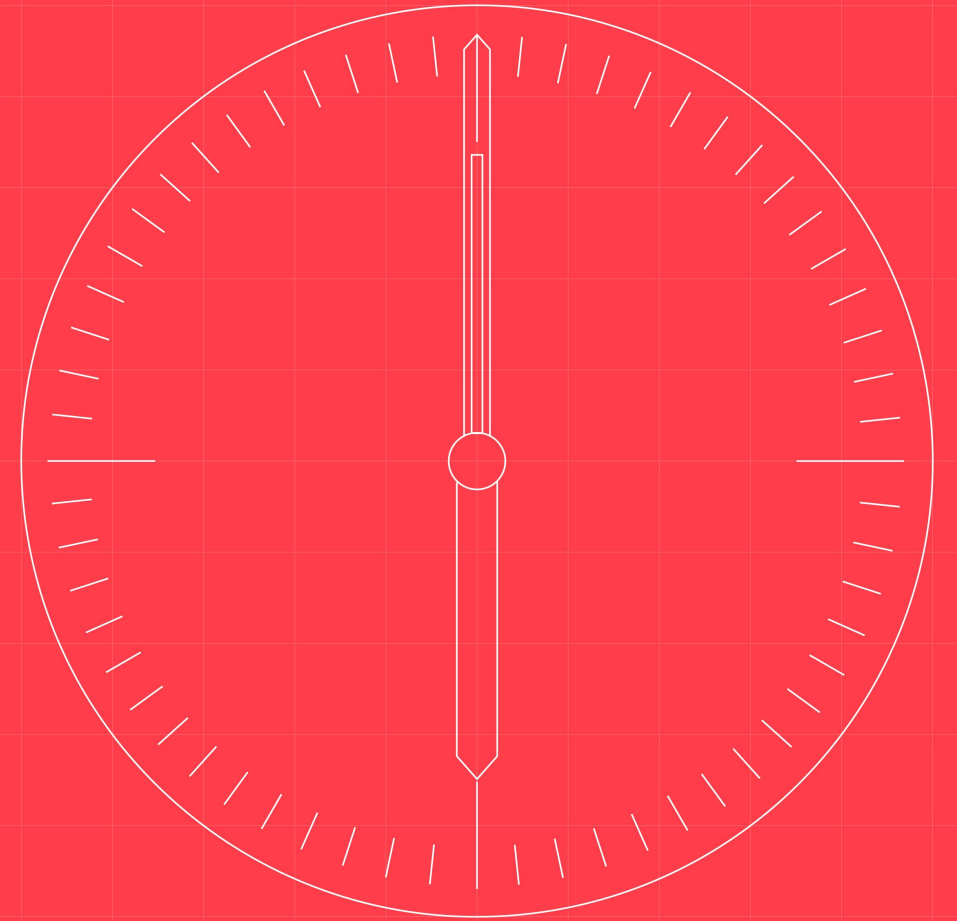


Navigating the enhanced Collaboration Base
